### **Tuition Exempt Students**

- Children of nonresident employees
- 9th - 12th grade London I.S.D. students
- Those who anticipate residence within 60 days and have proof
- Resident students who become nonresidents may complete the semester
- Resident students who have completed their junior year and who then become nonresidents may continue their senior year tuition-free.
- Students whose parent is active duty military at Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi may enroll tuition-free with a follow-up at each semester
- Students whose parent is a civilian/government employee on Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi may enroll tuition-free with a follow-up at each semester.
