**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING  
H1N1 VACCINATION CLINICS**

**FOR ALL FBISD STUDENTS, STAFF, PARENTS AND  
COMMUNITY MEMBERS**

Flour Bluff Independent School District has received H1N1 vaccinations and will be conducting a clinic for Flour Bluff ISD students, staff and the community at:

- **The High School Cafetorium on January 21, 2010 from 2:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.**

The District has mostly H1N1 injectable/shot (dead virus) vaccines and some nasal (live, attenuated virus) vaccines available at this time. Students or staff who have asthma, heart conditions or other health conditions should not take the nasal vaccine, but may be eligible for the injectable vaccine.

Parents **MUST** be present with their children in order for the children to receive a vaccination. Important questions regarding the current health of your child will be asked, prior to allowing your child to participate in the vaccination. There are also forms and permissions that must be completed on site in order for the child to receive the vaccination.

All children ages 6 months to 9 years old must receive two doses of the vaccine, at least 28 days apart. If your child has received the first dose of the H1N1 vaccine at another location and 28 days have not yet passed, your child will not be able to receive a second dose at this time. If 28 days have passed since the first dose and your child is enrolled at the designated campus, your child will be able to receive the second dose of the vaccine.

All parents will need to have a current picture ID available to show staff at the time of the clinic. Also, parents should bring the child's current immunization record, if available.
